1. Select a classic/vintage vehicle (pre-2000) that you would possibly like to own.
2. Beside your name (Classroom Bulletin Board) write down your choice. Only one model per student, so first come - first choice. No repeat models!!! (In other words, eg; Cuda means ALL versions of the Cuda) Model: \_\_\_\_\_
3. Search the Web for your choice of vehicle, and find as much information as you can on vehicle: options, engines, transmissions, interiors, and colours. Also find the Purchase cost (that year), current 2007 value, and how many models were produced, etc. The more information you collect the better your mark for this assignment.

### **Assignment Includes:**

1. Cover page includes: vehicle year, make and model. Vehicle logo, student's name, class, block and date submitted.
2. Summary pages includes: A summary in your own words of all data collected. (1½ - 2 pages in size 12 font, 1½ line spacing, with 1" margin on all sides). Vehicle year, make and model. A purchase cost (that year) of model researched and a current 2007 value and details of how this current value is determined. Short summary of vehicle history
3. Reference materials: Print out all the pages of relevant materials you find.
4. Picture pages includes: (2 – 4 pages) either colour or black/white.
5. Reference list page includes: a list of all web site addresses searched with relevant materials.
